WHAT TRAINING DO WE PROVIDE?

- **L1SKT Basic Spill Kit Training - Bronze Tier** - A spill kit course designed for individuals and operatives that may be employed in a shop floor location who must respond to minor day to day spills and leaks in their own work environment.
- **L2SRT First Responder - Silver Tier** - A spill response course for individuals who may either act as first responders to a spillage incident or as members of a spill response team.
- **L1SKTTT Trainer Spill Kit Training - Gold Tier** - This course enables the trainer to deliver a competent course to work colleagues at onshore facilities who may be called upon to deal with day to day spills in their workplace.

WHAT DOES THE SURVEY INCLUDE?

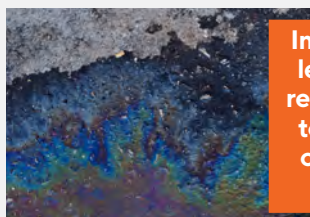

1. To provide operatives with the knowledge of how to safely use spill products on your site.
2. Highlight the importance of having a simple, effective, response action plan.
3. Stress the importance of preventing spillage escape and reducing impacts on the environment.
4. The training meets all Environmental Agency, DEFRA and ISO 14001 requirements.

L2SRT - SILVER FIRST RESPONDER TRAINING - 3.5 HOUR

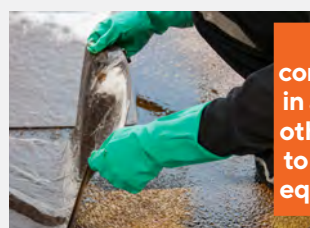
This testing is suitable for a max of 12 people

The L2SRT First responder course is made up of 1 x 3.5 hour session and is suitable for a maximum of 12 individuals.

Course Objectives

1. Provide an improved level of response to emergency spills and thereby help to reduce corporate exposure to risks of polluting the environment and consequent costs.
2. Improve the knowledge and understanding of the physical dangers of spillage, typical routes of escape from the site and how to safely use containment and adsorbent products to effectively control a spill.
3. Create awareness of individuals' moral and legal responsibilities for causing pollution from spillage entering the wider environment.
4. The training meets all Environmental Agency, DEFRA and ISO 14001 requirements.

L1SKTTT - GOLD TRAINER TRAINING - 4.5 HOUR

The L1SKTTT foundation course in spill response before moving on to present a course that will equip attendees to deliver the L1SKT. Certificate validity - 2 years from date of training.

Course Objectives

1. Provide trainers with an adequate level of subject knowledge.
2. Impart confidence to train colleagues to achieve a safe level of spill response.
3. Demonstrate understanding and proper use of all site spill response equipment.
4. The training meets all Environmental Agency, DEFRA and ISO 14001 requirements.

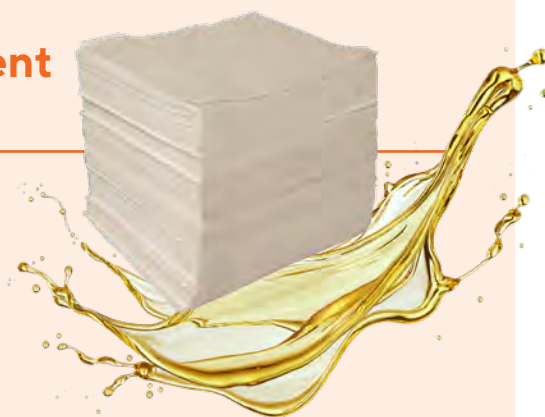
